

EGOS and *Organization Studies* held the 2nd Central and Eastern European (CEE) Workshop in Vilnius, Lithuania, October 27–28, 2016

EGOS and *Organization Studies* (OS), in collaboration with the OMT Division of the AOM, held for a second year a development workshop aimed at PhD students and early career scholars from universities based in Central and Eastern Europe. This year's workshop on the topic of "Challenges in Managing and Organizing Processes of Change" was attended by 24 scholars from 12 countries. The workshop provided a forum to discuss the participants' research as well as insights into the process of publishing in *Organization Studies* OS and the Journal of East European Management Studies (JEEMS).

The workshop was hosted by the Mykolas Romeris University.
