This process is more advanced in the humanities and some social sciences. Business schools need to join the process.

In this virtual workshop, we will explore what it means to decolonize the business school. We will also look at what this might look like in practice in terms of curriculum design, teaching, administration and research. During the workshop, we will bring together a group of experts on the topic who work in business schools as well as other disciplines. We will also encourage people to reflect on their own education practices and identify areas for change. Finally, we hope to identify specific actions that we can take to decolonize business schools.
